PROFESSIONAL SUMMARY:

Benjamin Sigerson (b. 2001) is a composer and jazz pianist from Vancouver, B.C. A recipient of a Bachelor's in Music Composition from McGill University in Montréal, Sigerson has won awards for his compositions in both classical and jazz idioms, and has been featured on several albums and concerts. His pieces have been performed internationally in concert stages, jazz clubs, and recording studios across Canada. As a songwriter, Sigerson has written over 150 pieces in jazz, folk, and pop music idioms. As a composer, he has written for orchestras to solo Erhu to hundred-member choirs. In addition to his work in writing and performing, Sigerson works on projects in musicology, and serves as the music director at St. Alban's Anglican Church in Richmond BC. His music has been recorded on several albums, including a recent recording funded by the Canada Council for the Arts for a five-keyboard ensemble. Being a Korean-Canadian artist based in BC, his music is inspired by nature, heritage, and moving around boundaries
